Your application dated 18 May 2021 refers.

The Energy Regulator at its meeting held on 7 May 2021 approved the guideline increase of 14.59% for municipalities applicable for 2021/22 financial year. Consequently, the Energy Regulator considered your application for a tariff increase for the period 1 July 2021 - 30 June 2022 and approved the tariffs as follows:
