1. Executive Summary

The purpose of this report is to provide the necessary information and motivation with regards to the proposed first amendment of Contract SC1969/2019: Appointment of consultants for various engineering and groundwater projects in the Overstrand Municipal area for a contract period ending 30 June 2022, in terms of the enabling provisions of section 116(3) of the Local Government: Municipal Finance Management Act, 2003 (Act 56 of 2003) (MFMA), to enable Council to take an informed decision when considering whether to consent to the proposed amendment of the contract.

6. Background/Evaluation/Conclusion

Background

Contract SC 1969/2019 for the appointment of consulting engineers was awarded by the Accounting Officer to 27 professional service providers on 1 August 2019 for a period ending on 30 June 2022. Please refer to Annexure E for the award, including the list of service providers. The service providers were appointed on a roster basis and were ranked per discipline across 19 engineering disciplines, for ad hoc appointment on projects by various departments in the municipality during the contract period as the need arises.

As the contract was due to end on 30 June 2022, a new tender document for the next 3 years period had already been prepared and approved by a Bid Specifications Committee meeting held on 23 February 2022. However, all new tender advertisements by organs of state were put on hold from 16 February 2022 in terms of advice received from National Treasury, following a ruling of the Constitutional Court. New tender advertisements are only set to continue during June 2022 following a Council resolution of 31 May 2022, whereby interim measures were approved to continue with tender processes.

As these professional services are essential for the implementation of the municipality's capital projects as well as several operational projects across various municipal departments, and it was not clear at the time by when it will be possible to advertise new tenders again, measures had to be taken to ensure the availability of these services after 30 June 2022.

It was therefore decided, after consultation between the Infrastructure & Planning and Finance Directorates, to embark on a contract amendment process in terms of section 116(3) of the MFMA, with the purpose of extending the contract's end date beyond 30 June 2022. Refer to Annexure A for the meeting minutes and motivation. The motivation is the following:

- a) The recent Constitutional Court ruling which questioned the validity of the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2017, and the subsequent moratorium on the advertisement of new tenders, prevented a new tender from being advertised and necessitated an alternative approach to ensure the continued availability of professional service providers to assist various departments in the municipality with the implementation of capital and operational projects from 1 July 2022.
- b) There was insufficient time available for a complete new tender process to be concluded before 1 July 2022, even though exemption was recently granted by National Treasury to allow the advertisement of new tenders.
- c) All the originally appointed service providers agreed to the proposed extension of the contract and all of them signed agreements to this effect.
- d) The proposed amendment of the contract will have no additional financial implication for the municipality as compared to a new tender process, as remuneration is done in terms of the nationally gazetted Engineering Council of South Africa (ECSA) fees, and the contract is on an as and when basis when funding is available.

- e) Only one representation was received, which did not question the validity of the municipality's proposed amendment of the contract.
- f) The successful amendment of the contract will contribute significantly to the timely implementation of the municipality's capital and operational programs, and sustainable service delivery.

The proposed amendment of the contract will serve at the Bid Adjudication Committee during June 2022 for recommendation to the Municipal Manager.

Evaluation

Section 116(3) of the MFMA provides as follows:

- (3) A contract or agreement procured through the supply chain management policy of the municipality or municipal entity may be amended by the parties, but only after—
- (a) the reasons for the proposed amendment have been tabled in the council of the municipality or, in the case of a municipal entity, in the council of its parent municipality; and
 - (b) the local community—
 - (i) has been given reasonable notice of the intention to amend the contract or agreement; and
 - (ii) has been invited to submit representations to the municipality or municipal entity.

Section 116(3) of the MFMA should be read together with MFMA Circular no. 73, issued by National Treasury in May 2013. In terms of the said circular, the following power/duty was conferred to Council, which is cited as follows (emphasis added):

“Considering the reasons for the proposed amendment of a contract or agreement and any representations that may have been received regarding the proposed amendment of a contract or an agreement procured through the supply chain management policy of the municipality and deciding whether to consent to the amendment of the contract or agreement.”

In terms of Section 116(3) of the MFMA, due process was followed, and the following activities were included in the process:

- A public notice, inviting comments from the local community and other interested persons was placed in the media on 14 April 2022. Refer to Annexure B.
- The proposed amendment of the contract will serve before the Overstrand Bid Adjudication Committee during June 2022, for recommendation of the proposed amendment to the Accounting Officer for approval.
- This submission to the Council meeting scheduled for 29 June 2022.

Only one representation was received before the closing date for comments, i.e. from the company Bergstan South Africa (Pty) Ltd (Bergstan) – refer to Annexure C. Bergstan stated that they do not question the validity of the proposed amendment but suggested that the contract be amended by one year instead of the initially proposed 3 years. An opinion was also obtained

from National Treasury, following the representation received from Bergstan, and they advised that the municipality should consider a shorter term for the amended contract period – refer to Annexure D.

Following discussions between the various municipal departments involved, it was decided to amend the proposed amended contract end date to 30 June 2023 instead of 30 June 2025, i.e. extension of the contract period by one year. All the SCM compliant originally appointed professional service providers agreed to the amended contract end date in writing.

Conclusion

All the processes required in terms of the MFMA for the amendment of the contract have been followed. The single representation received during the comments period did not oppose the proposed amendment of the contract in principle, but rather requested that a shorter contract period be considered by the municipality. National Treasury advised that a shorter contract period should be considered by the municipality, which was done after consultation between the various departments.

7. Financial Implications

Sources of Funding: Capital and Operating Budget Provisions

Remuneration of service providers on this contract is done in terms of the nationally gazetted ECSA fees, less discount of up to 15%, as originally tendered by the professional service providers. The proposed amendment of the contract will have no effect on the remuneration of service providers.

The contract is used on an ad hoc basis by any municipal department for the implementation of capital and operational projects where the municipality do not have the skills or capacity internally to do so.

The proposed amendment of the contract will not adversely affect the municipality's budget, as appointment of a service provider for a specific project can only proceed if funds are already approved on the budget.

9. Comments from other Departments, Divisions and Administrations

Contracts Management:

It is confirmed that the content of this submission is in full compliance with the regulatory requirements of Section 116(3) of the MFMA, 2003, and the Overstrand Supply Chain- and Contract Management Policy Frameworks. Since the contracts are of tariff nature, and the contract values could therefore not be determined from the beginning of the contract, Circular 62 of National

Treasury recommends that a public participation process be followed to amend the contracts (section 116(3) of the MFMA).

The period advertised for public comments and recommendations ended on 13 May 2022. Cognisance should be taken that one representation, from Bergstan South Africa (Pty) Ltd, was received by closing date, 13 May 2022.



RE: PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT SC 1969/2019: CONSULTING ENGINEERS FOR VARIOUS ENGINEERING AND GROUNDWATER PROJECTS IN THE OVERSTRAND AREA

DATE: 25 MARCH 2022

A recent discussion between the Directors of Finance and Infrastructure & Planning refers.

As discussed, herewith the motivation for the proposed amendment of Contract SC 1969/2019, Consulting Engineers for various Engineering and Groundwater projects in the Overstrand Municipal area.

The abovementioned 3 years term contract was awarded to 27 different companies on 1 August 2019 and will end on 30 June 2022. The contract is used on an as and when required basis by several departments of the municipality during the implementation of a variety of capital and operational projects. Remuneration in terms of the contract is based on the gazetted fee structure of the Engineering Council of South Africa (ECSA).

A new contract for these professional engineering services has to be in place by 1 July 2022, in order to ensure that the municipality's 2022/23 budgets can be spent as planned, and that service delivery will continue. Unfortunately all new tender advertisements have been stopped by the Overstrand Municipality and many other government institutions following a recent Circular received from National Treasury, indicating that there is uncertainty about the legality of the BB-BEE Regulations due to a ruling of the Constitutional Court.

The specifications for the new tender, SC2296/2022, was 100% completed and approved by the Bid Specifications Committee on 23 February 2022 and would have been advertised on 4 March 2022, with closing date 8 April 2022. The advertising process was stopped during the week of 1 March 2022 following the National Treasury Circular. This will be the first amendment to Contract SC 1969/2019. The contract is rates based for ad hoc assignments, and therefore no fixed contract amount exists that has to be amended, but only the contract period has to be extended, to ensure continuity during the period where new tenders cannot be advertised or awarded.

The motivation for the proposed amendment is as follows:


1. Various municipal departments depend on assistance from consulting engineers to implement capital and operational projects, and a "gap" in these services can lead to underspending of budgets, lack of project implementation, and eventually deterioration of service delivery. The continuation of services by the current service providers will ensure continuity until a new contract can be awarded.

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2. The amendment of the contract **will** have no adverse financial implications for the municipality, as remuneration in terms of the contract is based on the ECSA gazetted fee structure and will continue under the same terms and conditions.

It is therefore recommended that Contract SC 1969/2019 be amended in terms of section 116(3) of the MFMA, by extending the contract for a three year period with start date 1 July 2022 and end date 30 June 2025.

Signed letters of Intent will be requested from all professional service providers currently appointed on the roster on Contract SC 1969/2019.

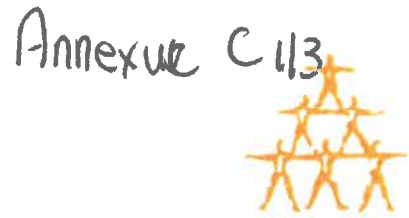

Dear Sir,

We have been alerted to your intention to extend the three-year term-tender (SC1969/2019) by a further three years. Although our own submission was apparently not successful, the implications are that we will now be excluded from work of this nature for approximately six years to the Overstrand Municipality.

We are not questioning the validity of your decision, but we would like to appeal to you to consider some concession that may allow us to continue to participate in the engineering design development of the Overstrand Municipality. We believe that our original professional competence has been substantially enhanced over the past few years and we have learnt much from our efforts in other municipalities also. In addition, we have built many years of professional experiences since we changed our name from Liebenberg & Stander to Bergstan. This gives us over 60 years of growth. We believe that there could be several other consultants who may be equally dismayed by the barrier that the additional three years may bring.

We have noted, with understanding, that National Treasury have revised their approach to the uncertainty relating to the adjustment of the Preferential Procurement Regulations (2017) and have provided organs of state with leeway to request exemptions from the provisions in the Act for procurement requirements. (We have attached a copy of the Advisory Note that Treasury issued in March 2022).

We, respectfully, suggest that Overstrand could benefit if it is willing to freshen its Roster of Consultants so that a renewed set could be reviewed. This would ensure that the Municipality has an excellent chance to verify the quality, variety and responsiveness of the Consultants that would now be available after 3 years. We believe that it would be prudent to let the current arrangement continue for another year to allow for unfinished issues.

Please could you kindly reconsider or assist in some way? Any additional clarification can be directed to the undersigned if further information is required.

Advisory note: Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 - Minister of Finance v Afribusiness NPC [2022] ZACC 4

1. I refer to my communication of 25 February 2022 informing organs of state that the Minister will, on an urgent basis, seek confirmation from the Constitutional Court that the invalidity of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 (the 2017 Regulations), has been and continues to be suspended for a period of 12 months.
2. Please note that the communication of 25 February 2022 is an advisory note in response to the numerous requests for guidance regarding how to deal with the implications of the Constitutional Court judgment. Please further note that the advice referred to in that communication excludes procurement with a Rand value of less than R30 000 obtained through price quotations and petty cash.
3. According to section 217(2) of the Constitution, read with section 2 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (PPPFA), organs of state must determine a preferential procurement policy. This policy and procurement decisions must be made by an accounting officer/authority in line with the framework set out in section 2 of the PPPFA and other applicable legislation.
4. The PPPFA requires that the threshold amounts in which the 80/20 and 90/10 preference point systems must be utilised, together with the formula to be applied, must be prescribed by regulations, in terms of section 2(1)(b) and (c). Such regulations are necessary for organs of state to implement their preferential procurement policies.
5. National Treasury is preparing new draft regulations in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act), to be published for comment in the week of 7 March 2022. The draft regulations will provide for amounts and the formula that must be prescribed by regulation in terms of section 2(1)(b) and (c) of the Act and any matter that may be necessary or expedient to prescribe in order to achieve the objects of the Act.
6. Until the new regulations take effect or the Constitutional Court's clarity on the suspension of the invalidity of the 2017 Regulations is provided, whichever occurs first, an organ of state may, in terms of section 3(c) of the Act, request an exemption from the provisions of the Act for a specific procurement or category of procurement requirements. Such requests should be limited to



procurement requirements that cannot await the new regulations or the Constitutional Court's guidance.

7. The papers for seeking the Constitutional Court's clarity are being finalised and organs of state will be advised once these are filed, and of further developments.






