OCTOBER 2024

No recorded activities for the Incident Command Centre apart from the call-taking and dispatching of crew and team members.

NOVEMBER 2024

A wildfire started on 17 November 2024 in the Hemel and Aarde Valley, and subsequently turned into a multi-day fire. To better manage the incident, the principles of ICS (Incident Command System) were applied. While the Emergency Control Room is responsible for call-taking and dispatching, the Emergency Control Room Operators received training on ICS 100 and ICS 200 which was provided by the Western Cape Government: Disaster Management, Fire and Rescue Services. The training allowed the operators to gain better insight and understanding of conditions which may arise outside of the control room and provided exposure to assist the operational firefighters who are busy fighting the fire on the ground.

At the particular incident, the communication was very challenging, with radio communication being hampered. Radio communication was not available across the jurisdiction and only certain areas could communicate with each other. The fire started in the Hemel and Aarde Valley at Glenfruin and spread deeper into the valley, burning over the mountain into Tekili Farm and spread towards the Karwyderskraal and Hawston/Fisherhaven area. To address this challenge, operators were sent into the field with a tablet to capture critical information which could not be relayed to the control room by the division or group supervisor. Communication could occur in line of sight within a specific radius but not from the division supervisor back to the Emergency Control Room.

This exercise gave exposure to the Operators in terms of conditions at fires, as well as exposure to the administrative elements of ICS, which is a well documented and recorded "event".

Additionally, other members of the Incident Command, Emergency Control and Support Services division assisted with logistical arrangements firstly by coordinating ground team resources by checking the teams in and out and secondly by distributing food to the members on the fire line who are unable to leave, as well as receive and document donations received by businesses and individuals. Checking teams in ensures for better command and control of the total resources available on the fire line.

For the duration of the fire, media releases were drafted for the communications department to obtain approval by the Municipal Manager before posting it on social media.

DECEMBER 2024

Multiple wildfires were reported to the Emergency Control Room during December 2024 of which two subsequently turned into extended wildfires. The first wildfire started on Christmas day and is known as the Rotary Way Fire. The second wildfire started on 29 December 2024 and is known as the Voelklip fire.

During both of the incidents the Emergency Control Room where responsible for capturing all details related to the incident, while the Supervisor: Emergency Control assisted the operational department with the administrative component of ICS.

For the month of December, a situational report was also opened up on 16 December 2024 and all incidents for the festive period (for this instance up until New Years Eve) were linked to the situational report. The situation report will give an overview of the type of incidents which occurred over a certain period.

In addition, employees participated in the visibility drives on New Years Eve and were stationed at strategic points to ensure that the Overstrand jurisdiction is covered in the event of a flare or firework that caused a fire. Two flares landed in Hawston which had the potential to turn into wildfires which was quickly extinguished by the community; the arriving firefighters ensured the scene was safe before departing from the incident location.
