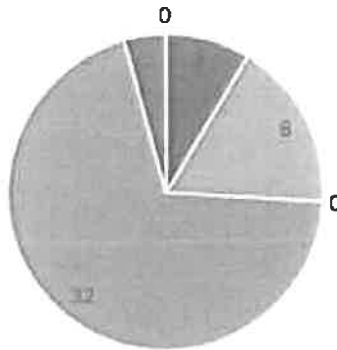

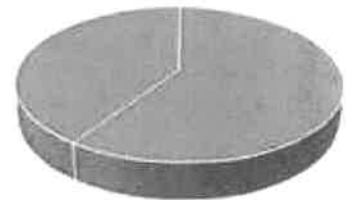

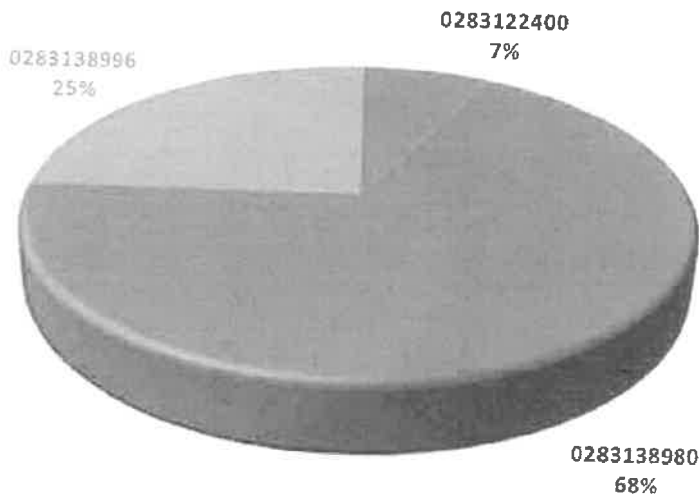


COMPARISON OF INCOMING VS OUTGOING CALLS

-AUG 2025**



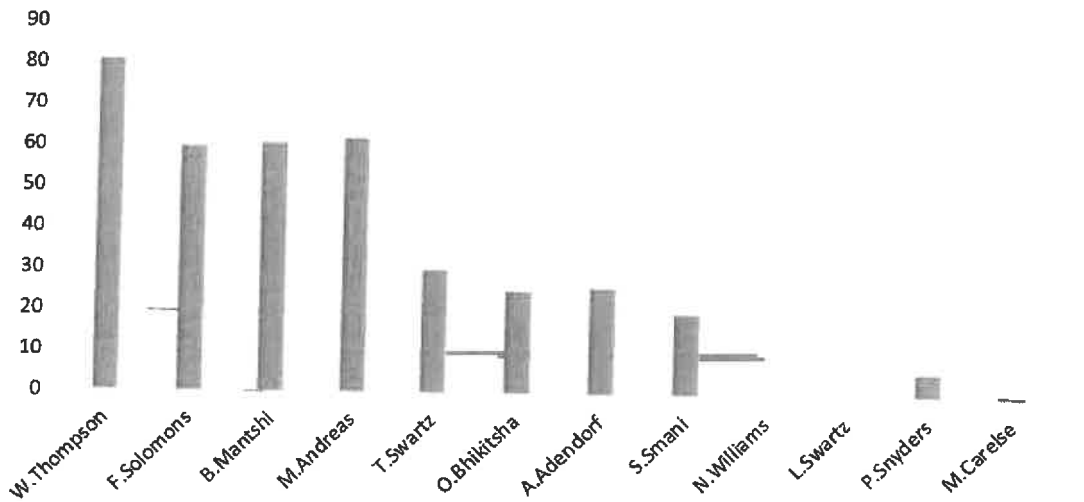
**BREAKDOWN OF OUTGOING CALLS

STAFF COMPLIANCE:

The SANS 10090: Community Protection Against Fires provide the guidelines regarding communication within an Emergency Control Room. Refer to 5.2.3.2 – 5.2.3.4

5.2.3.2 Telephone lines

Lines should be subdivided as follows:

- a number of lines shall be dedicated to emergency calls only (see table 4); and
- at least one line for administration.

NOTE The number of lines for administration will be determined by the brigade's needs.

5.2.3.3 Control centre operators and or supervisors

5.2.3.3.1 There should be sufficient operators so that calls are answered within 15 s and appropriate response dispatched within 30 s of the call being completed.

5.2.3.3.2 It should not take longer than 60 s to take the call once the phone is answered.

5.2.3.4 Supervisors

For up to two operators, access to a supervisor is required. For three or more operators, a supervisor shall be on duty in the control centre.



The Directorate: Municipal Public Safety currently has one emergency landline (028 312 2400) , and two other general landlines (028 313 8980 & 028 313 8996) stationed within the Emergency Control Room. These lines must be manned by two operators per shift. Currently .the Overstrand population stands at 132,495 inhabitants. Therefore as per Table 4 ,3 Emergency landlines are required.

The shift comprises of four shifts, with two operators per shift; shifts run from 06:00 until 18:00 and vice versa. The Senior Supervisor Emergency (Control Room) work day shift duties Monday – Friday between 07:45 and 16:30.

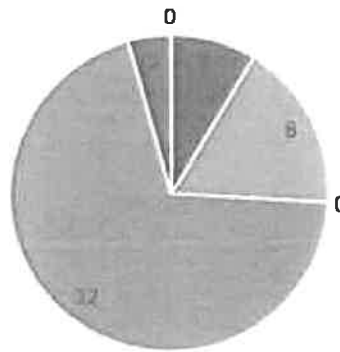
