INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this plan is to ensure to reduce the hazards within the Overstrand Area.

Define vulnerable communities

Vulnerable communities can be defined as a part of a “population” that experience a higher risk of poverty and social exclusion that the general population. This sector requires particular effort to be made at all levels of policy planning and implementation to inform amongst other resource allocations.

Disaster risk reduction (DRR) protects the lives and livelihoods of communities and individuals who are most vulnerable to disaster or any emergencies. Disaster can be cause by both human & nature (or a combination of both) The DRR main focus is to ensure that there is a reduction in the communities by concentrating on the following dimension within the vulnerable communities:

- Exposure to hazards
- Vulnerability and capacity
- Characteristics of each hazard

The above-mentioned items will minimize or prevent any new risks, it can also ensure that the existing risk can be reduce and increase resilience overall.

Three important factors involving Disaster Management in vulnerable communities include the next phase:

- Preparedness
- Response
- Recovery
