WHAT IS FRAUD

An unlawful and intentional act of misrepresentation.

3. False and inaccurate information supplied

on employee performance evaluation

Which is prejudicial or potentially prejudicial to another.



WHAT CAUSES FRAUD? **Fraud Triangle Theory**

3. Allow unauthorized persons to enter municipal



Financial pressure - by unrealistic goals, targets, and possible incentives for committing the fraud.

Opportunity - due to lack or weakness of controls and oversight.

Rationalization - thoughts from a fraudster like "I'm owed," "I'll pay it back later, "insignificant to the municipality," etc.
