

RESORT CONDITIONS

1. BOOKING OFFICE HOURS: Monday- Friday 08h00-13h00 & 14h00-16h30

2. Tariff charges are payable in advance, prior to entry and the occupation of campsites in the Resort. No requests for bookings will be accepted from persons who are in arrears regarding payments from previous bookings at the Resort. Any payments made by persons in arrears; will be allocated to outstanding camping fees.

- 3. All applications for refunds are to be lodged in terms of Council procedures.
- 4. Campers are required to register upon arrival. Admission time for campers is from 12:00 in the afternoon, on the date of arrival. The entrance gate closes at 20:00; ensure that you arrive before closing time (please note that the Reception area is closed daily between 13h00-13h45). Campsites must be vacated by 10:00 in the morning, on the date of departure.
- 5. A R157.00 Gate Card / Tag / Key (cash) Deposit is payable for each vehicle upon arrival, and is refundable on the day of departure. The deposit will be forfeited if the Gate Card / Tag / Key is lost or visibly damaged. The refunding of Gate Tag Deposits can only take place during office hours

6. CODE OF CONDUCT

- 6.1 The consumption of alcoholic beverages is limited to guests' allocated campsites. Drunkeness or alcohol abuse is strictly prohibited.
- 6.2 (i) No loud music allowed within the Resort
 - (ii) No music allowed from 22h00-09h00

(iii)Music that offends any other person is not permitted

- 6.3 Swearing and shouting, or any noise which may disturb the peace of any person is not permitted.
- 6.4 Generators are not allowed to be used on the campsites.
- 6.5 No firearms or fireworks are permitted.
- 6.6 No dogs are allowed in the Resort.
- 6.7 Fires may be made in designated areas only.
- 6.8 Campsites must be kept tidy and litter-free by using the bins provided.
- 6.9 Motorcycles, Quad bikes, or Go-carts are not allowed to be driven in the Resort.
- 6.10 The speed limit in the resort is 20km/h, and pedestrians have right of way. Normal rules of the road apply in the Resort.
- 6.11 Camping and parking are permitted on allocated campsites only.
- 6.12 No loitering in close proximity to any facilies (ablutions/kitchens/laundryrooms) is permitted.

6.13 Picking of flowers, damage to the natural environment and feeding of wild animals such as baboons are strictly prohibited. The Milkwood trees are a protected species; damaging them is a criminal offence and offenders will be prosecuted.

6.14 Special arrangements must be made with the Camp Manager to allow day visitors. Visiting hours are between 08h00- 20h00.

6.15 Campers are cautioned against burglary/theft, and are advised to be vigilant and safeguard personal belongings accordingly.

- Day visitors for campers up to a maximum of four (4)* = R62.00per person per day and R48.00 for a vehicle.

(*) Special arrangements must be made with the Camp Manager to allow day visitors

- Children under two (2) years are free and children under twelve (12) years at half price.
- Low Season: Pensioners, Caravan Clubs more than 10 caravans, Mobile Camper Vehicles & RV groups (not caravans) more than 20 campers (Pensioners to be defined as persons sixty (60) years and older)
 - ✤ May get a discount of 50% on the stands;
 - Qualify for a reduced tariff of R2908.00 for a period of 30 days.
