He encouraged the ward committee members to inform their sectors and blocks of public meetings to ensure that the community members that they represent attend the scheduled meetings. He further recommended the use of the citizen app for service delivery complaints to ensure the swift attention of the municipality to these needs. The executive mayor raised concern about the recent sewerage blockage that took two and a half days to clear and encouraged ward committee members to assist with educating community members on illegal dumping.</p> <p>Ward committee members raised questions on the electricity project progress and various other service delivery concerns.
