5.1	Overstrand Draft IDP Review and Budget Public Consultation Cllr A Komani referred to the IDP Review and Budget Public Consultation document compiled in the agenda and reminded those present of the productive report shared by the Executive Mayor. He gave time for the members to raise questions, none were raised. NOTED

6.1	Ward Specific Projects: Ward 2 To remain on the agenda for the next ordinary ward committee meeting. NOTED	
6.2	Masakhane Field: Update on Caretaker (Mr L September) Mr L September enquired on the progress of the Ward Specific Project: Caretaker's residence. Cllr A Komani replied that he is reporting on the information received from Ald Nqinata and gave an explanation to the members that the funding made available was not sufficient for this project and therefore was utilized for other projects such as fencing and artificial grass for ECD's and playparks. He further reported that the funding of this project was utilized for artificial grass for the playpark. Mr L September expressed his dissatisfaction with the fact that this decision was made without his knowledge and after he had already informed his organisation accordingly, he will now have to go back and inform them of the status.	

	Mr S Sompma mentioned that the members attending this meeting unanimously expresses their dissatisfaction with the decisions that were made that lead to these changes. Ms D Siduka raised her concern and enquired on where is this specific playpark which is referred to? She further mentioned that she liaised with the Councillor for burglar bars at the ECD which is a municipal building, the Councillor told her that the municipality will install the burglar bars, she further elaborated that no report was given by Cllr A Komani in this regard. She further mentioned that the fencing of the ECD in Masakhane was not communicated with her, she referred to the answer the Councillor gave her which was “that the municipality made that decision” and mentioned that it was decided without consulting Ms Siduka in this regard. Mr L September then confirmed that the last voice note received from the Councillor states that she will be in discussion about the project and then afterwards contact Mr L September and arrange for him to meet them at the field where-after the plan will be drafted accordingly.
