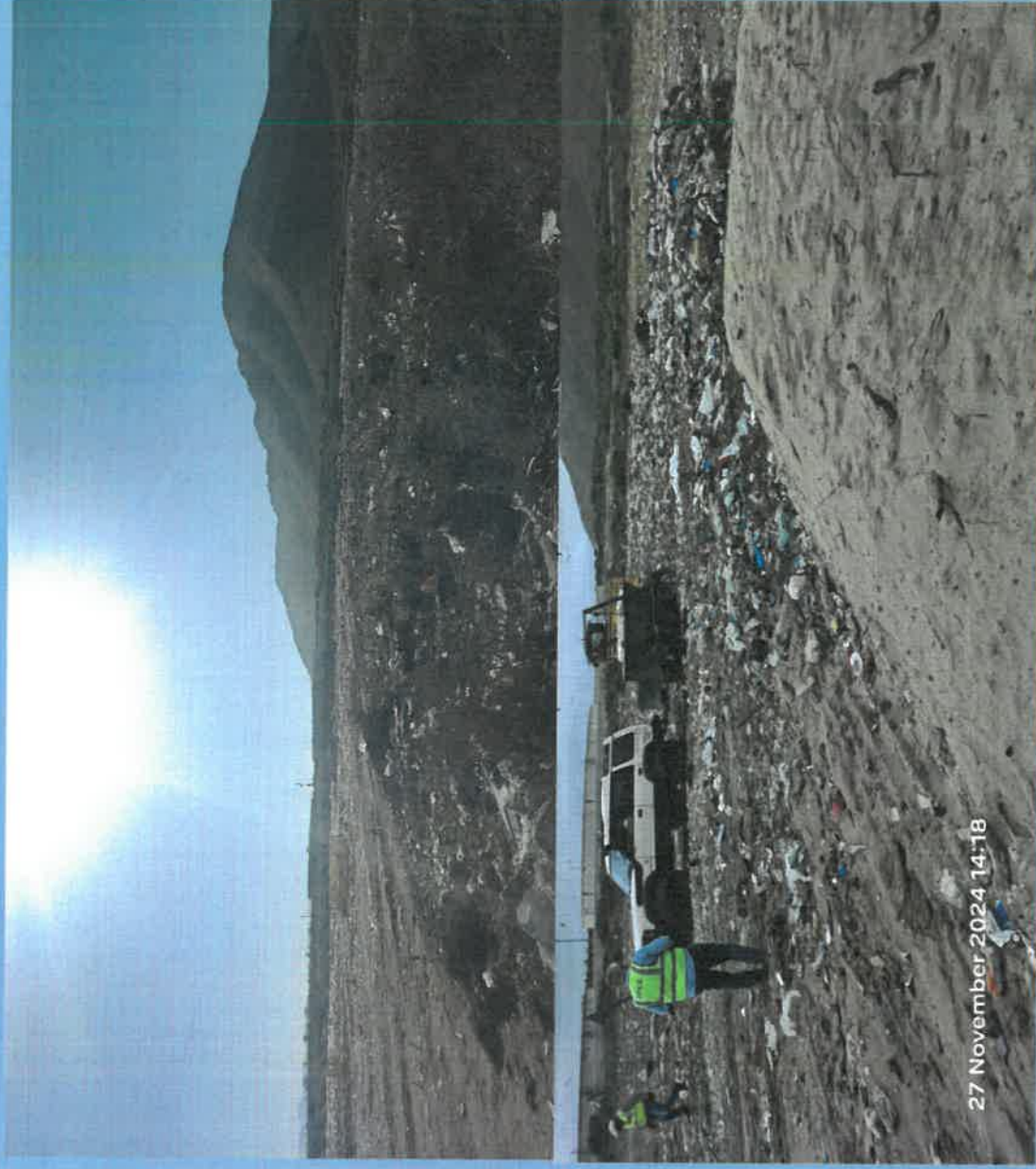

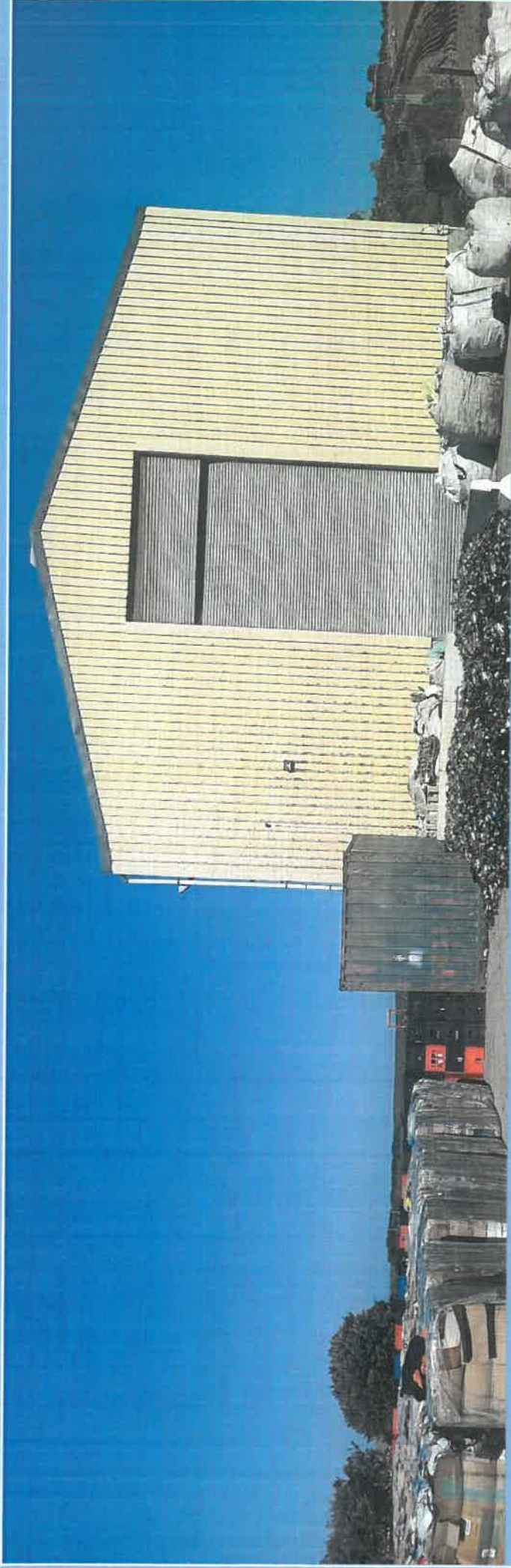
Average monthly tons managed on site for the last 12 months (Nov 2024 to Sep 2025)

(12 months / July 24 – June 2025)

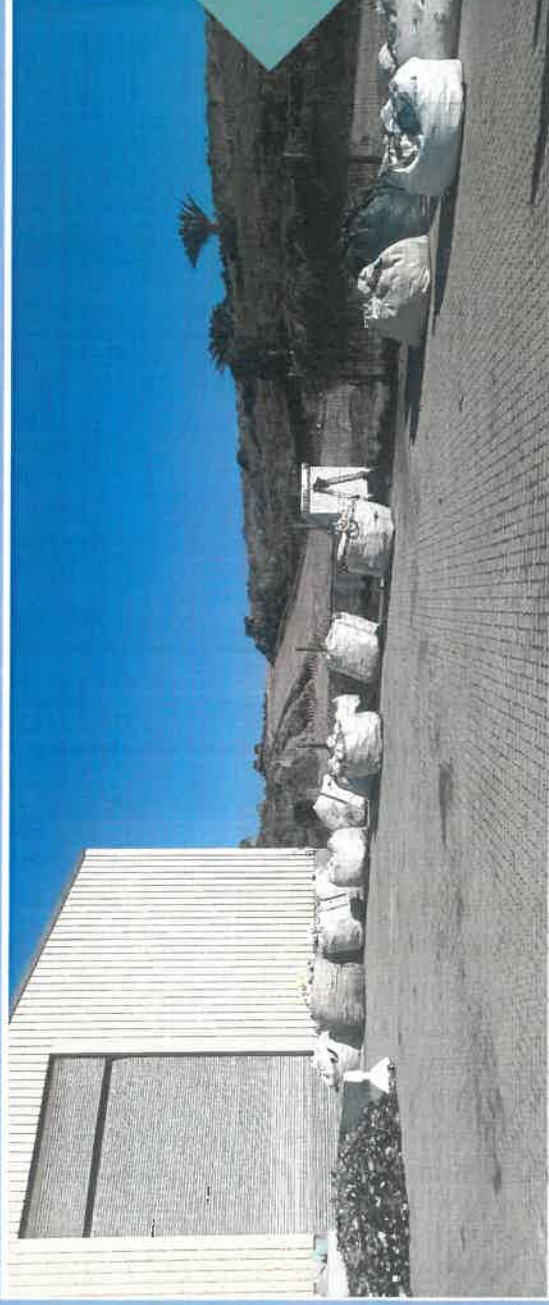


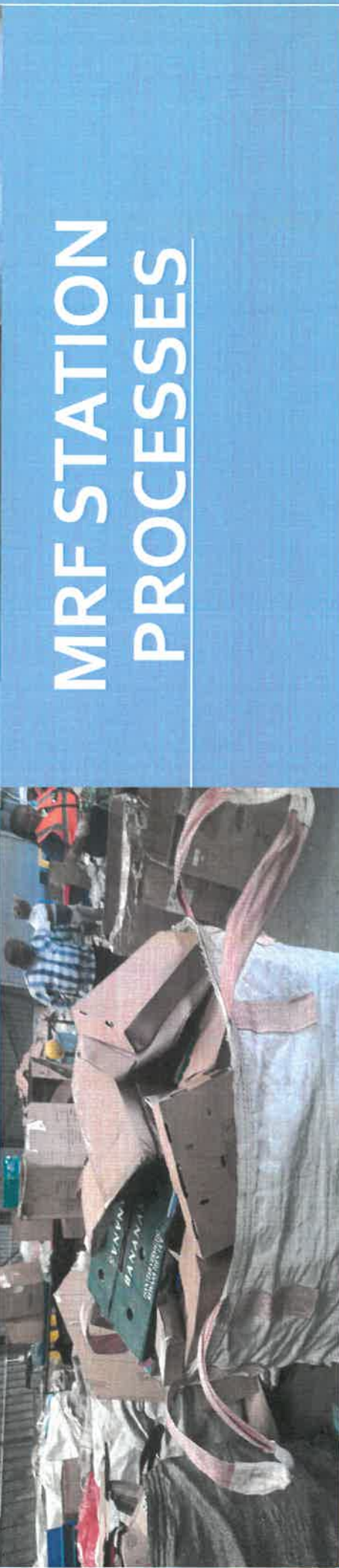

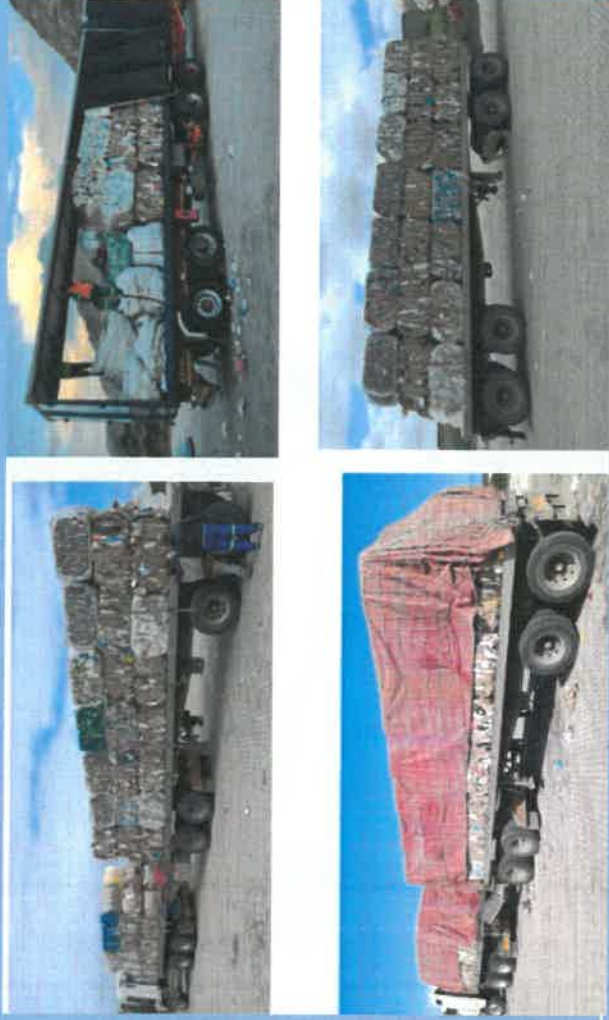




PROCESS OF SORTING GLASS CONTAINERS
